

BUGSY MALONE JR. AUDITION DIALOGUE

Boys memorize the part of BUGSY. Girls memorize the part of BLOUSEY. Put as much expression as you can into your audition. Remember: Acting is not just memorizing and saying your lines. Great actors use both their voices AND their bodies to tell a story.

(BUGSY is trying to befriend BLOUSEY. She is uninterested in him.)

Can I give you a lift?	BUGSY
You got a car?	BLOUSEY
Er, no.	BUGSY
Then how you gonna give me a lift, Buster? Put me in an elevator?	BLOUSEY
It's a nice night, we could walk. Which way you going?	BUGSY
Which way you going?	BLOUSEY
This way. <i>(Points left)</i>	BUGSY
Then I'm going this way. <i>(Moves right)</i>	BLOUSEY
Let me carry your bag at least. Have you eaten?	BUGSY
Ever since I was a child.	BLOUSEY
Then how come you're so skinny smarty?	BUGSY
I watch my weight.	BLOUSEY
Yeah, I do that when I'm broke too. You hungry?	BUGSY
No.	BLOUSEY
You're not hungry?	BUGSY
No, starving.	BLOUSEY
